I. CALL TO ORDER AND INTRODUCTIONS

The Tuscarawas Campus Faculty Council Meeting was called to order at 12:52

II. NEW BUSINESS

Pech proposes a vote to ratify the proposed articulation agreement with Stark State. Pech adds that this agreement will substantially ease the process of students entering our program from Stark State. Students will need to meet the GPA standards and sit the Praxis One test before full acceptance. Additional math and science courses will need to be taken and have been written into the articulation agreement. These math and science courses can be taken in conjunction with other courses at Stark State through Kent- Stark or at our campus. Osikiewicz asks for clarification regarding who is offering math and science courses. Pech reiterates that it is offered through Kent – Stark. Fuller asks if students are required to take English II. Pech answers that they are required to take English II. Lee points out that the correct course number for the proposed history course is 12071 instead of 12072. Gerbig asks how many courses could be taken at Kent - Stark without coming here. Pech responds there are 4 courses they can take at Kent – Stark, or what are referred to as “bridge courses”. A human biology lab is required but is offered at Stark.

A vote is taken and the agreement is passed unanimously.
