Seneca District Klondike Campsite Inspection Criteria**-Requirements for Site selection and layout (worth 5 points, all or nothing)**

Out of way of main throughways, Located on durable surface (not trampling flora, or eroding land), Tents set up properly, Free from dangerous tree branches or weather exposures

-Requirements for safety (worth 6 points, all or nothing)

Fire buckets per tent and per fire, Cooking and fire areas away from tents, Food stored properly, Fire appropriate size, (If applicable) Ax yard meets BSA Standards

-Requirements for cleanliness (worth 6 points, all or nothing)

Campsite free of trash and litter, Fire free of overly large, half burned and/ or excessive logs, Trash stored in an appropriate manner

-“Sharpness” (worth 0- 3 points)

Sharpness is best described as the extra mile to make the campsite look sharp this is the only category where partial points may be earned.

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CAMP RULES AND USEFUL INFORMATION FOR SENECA KLONDIKE.

KLONDIKE HEADQUARTERS WILL BE AT THE MANATOC TRAINING LODGE.

WE WILL HAVE COFFEE, TEA, COCOA, FOR THE **SCOUTMASTERS AND ASSISTANTS ONLY** AT KLONDIKE HEADQUARTERS.

COST OF THE EVENT WILL BE **\$6.00**. (COVERS COST OF RIBBONS, PATCHES, AND CAMP FEES.)
REMEMBER: ONLY THOSE SCOUTS AND SCOUTERS THAT ARE PREREGISTERED ARE GUARANTEED A PATCH.

ALL CARS MUST BE PARKED IN THE PARKING LOTS. **NO VEHICLES ARE PERMITTED AT THE CAMPSITES.**

ALL TRASH & GARBAGE IS TO BE BAGGED AND PLACED IN DUMPSTER LOCATED BY THE DINING HALL.

FIRES:

FOR GROUND FIRES, IF SOD IS REMOVED IT MUST BE REPLACED. ALL FIREWOOD IS TO BE REMOVED FROM THE CAMPSITE AND PLACED BACK IN THE WOODS. ALL FIRES WILL BE COLD TO THE TOUCH BEFORE LEAVING CAMP.

COOKING:

THE LIQUID FUEL POLICY OF THE GREAT TRAIL COUNCIL AND THE BSA WILL PREVAIL. (PROPANE CANISTERS ARE OKAY) IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT EVENING CAMP FIRES SHOULD BE LIMITED TO THE TROOP LEVEL RATHER THAN INDIVIDUAL PATROLS.

SAFETY:

EACH UNIT SHOULD HAVE ITS OWN FIRST AID KIT. **A FIRST AID STATION WILL BE SET-UP AT THE MANATOC HEALTH LODGE AND MANNED BY TRAINED STAFF MEMBERS.**

NO ALCOHOL, FIREARMS, OR SHEATH KNIVES ARE PERMITTED IN CAMP.

DRUGS, OTHER THAN THOSE PRESCRIBED BY YOUR PHYSICIAN AND IN THEIR PHARMACY LABELED CONTAINER, ARE NOT ALLOWED AT THE CAMP.

POSSESSION OF ANY OF THE ABOVE ITEMS COULD RESULT IN IMMEDIATE DISMISSAL FROM CAMP AND IF WARRANTED AUTHORITIES WILL BE NOTIFIED. (NO TOLERANCE POLICY)

CHECK-IN PROCEDURE:

ALL UNITS WILL CHECK IN AT THE EVENT HEADQUARTERS, AND SUBMIT **TWO (2) COPIES** OF YOUR **UNIT ROSTER** AS PROVIDED IN YOUR PACKET AND A **HEALTH FORM** FOR EACH **SCOUT AND SCOUTER**. ONE COPY OF THE UNIT ROSTER IS FOR THE DISTRICT AND ONE TO REGISTER YOU WITH THE CAMPMASTERS (**EXCEPTION: IF YOU HAVE RENTED ANY OF THE OTHER CABINS YOU HAVE TO CHECK IN WITH THE CAMPMASTERS FIRST THEN WITH US AT HEADQUARTERS. YOU ALSO HAVE TO MAKE YOUR OWN ARRANGEMENTS TO CHECK OUT WITH THE CAMPMASTERS.**)

ANYONE LEAVING CAMP AT ANY TIME BEFORE THE END OF THE KLONDIKE PLEASE CHECK OUT AT SENECA HEADQUARTERS WITH THE KLONDIKE STAFF.
