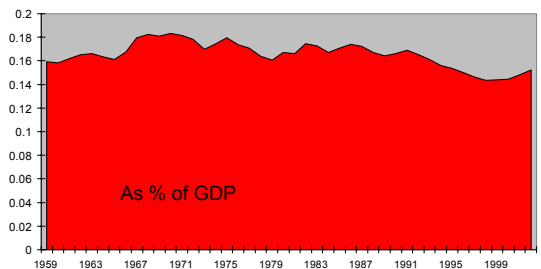
Government Spending 1959-2003



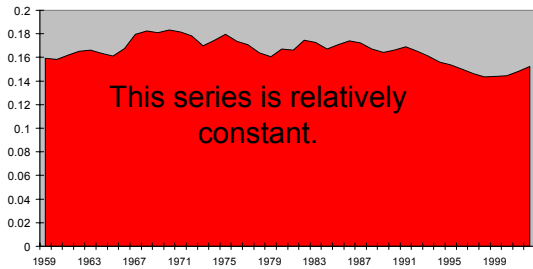

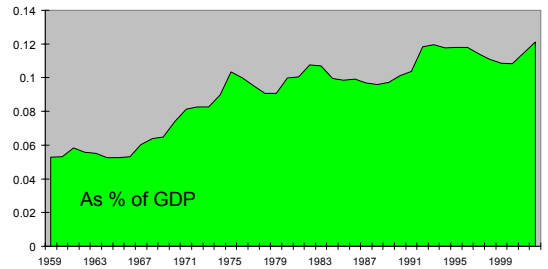
Govt. Consumption 1959-2003



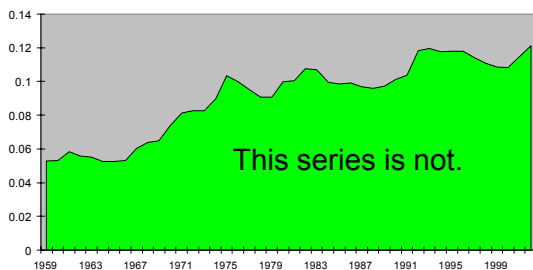

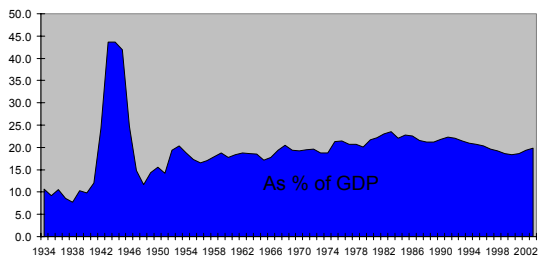

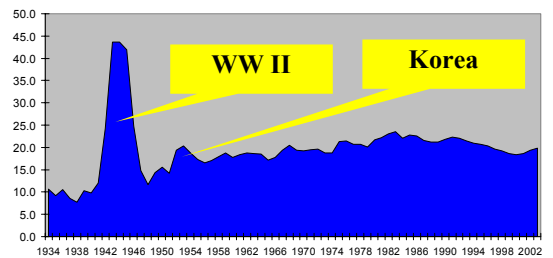

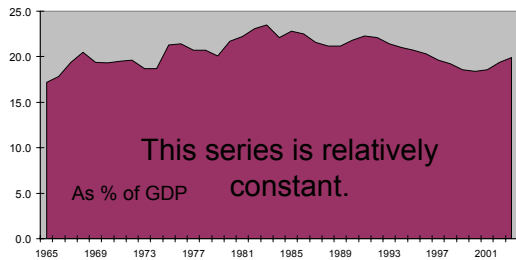
Federal Spending 1934-2003



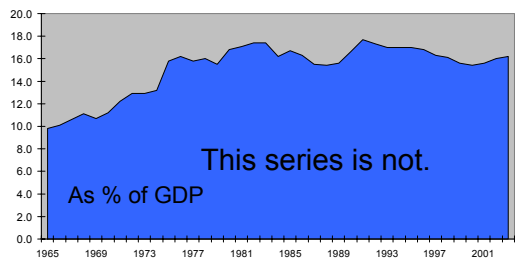

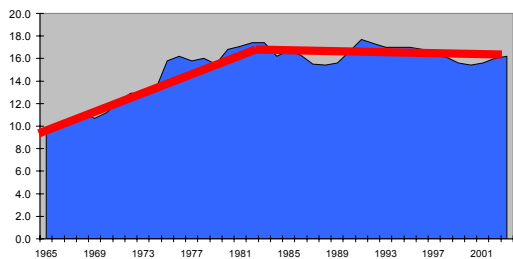
Federal Spending (1965-2003)



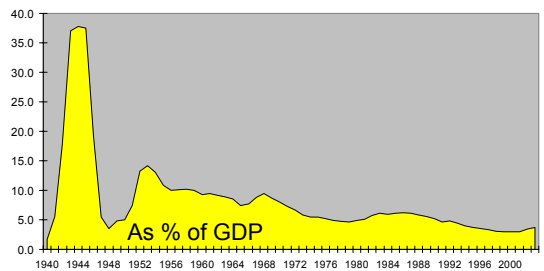
Federal Non-Defense Spending (1965-2003)



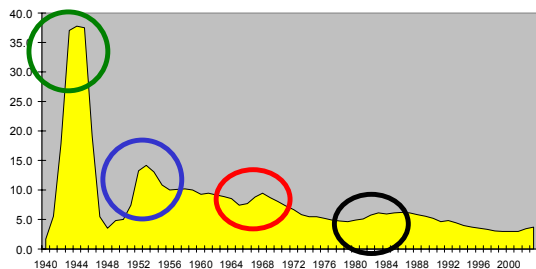

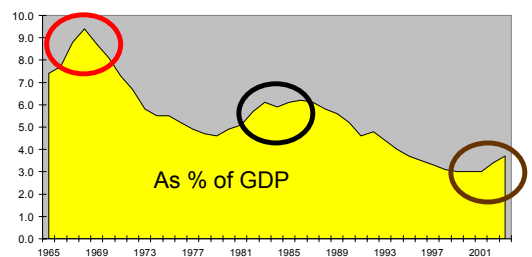
Defense Spending (1940-2003)



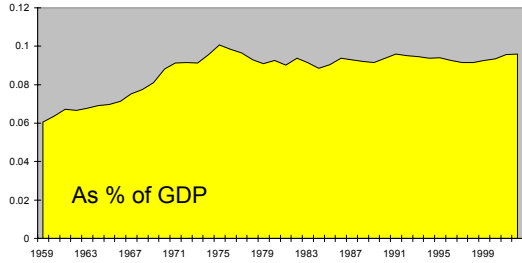

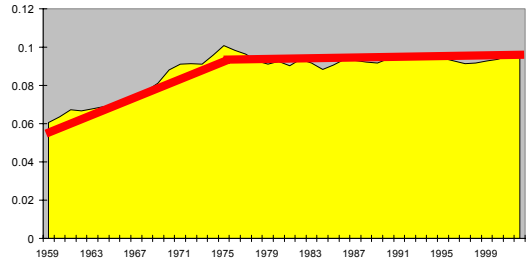

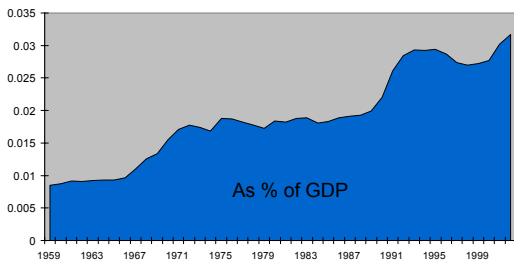
State and Local Consumption, 1960-2002



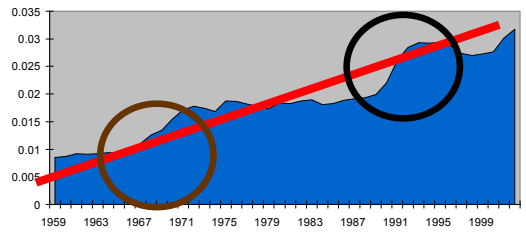

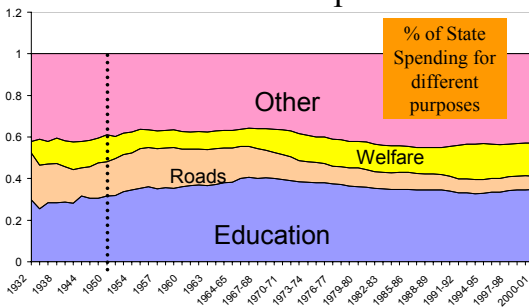
State and Local Transfer Payments, 1960-2002



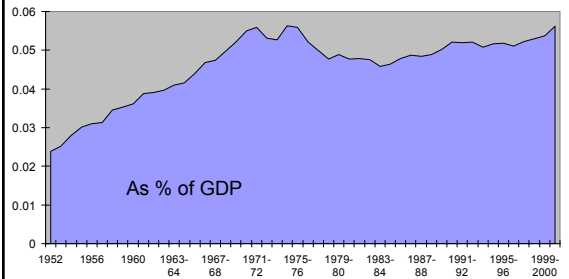

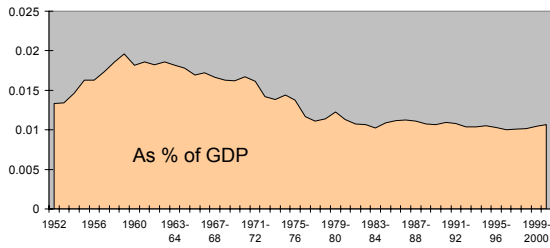

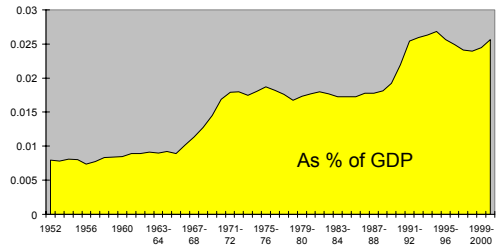
State Spending on Education, 1953-2001



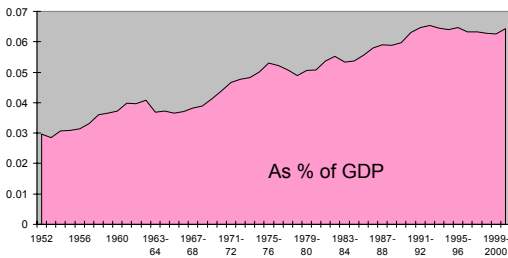
State Spending on Roads, 1953-2001



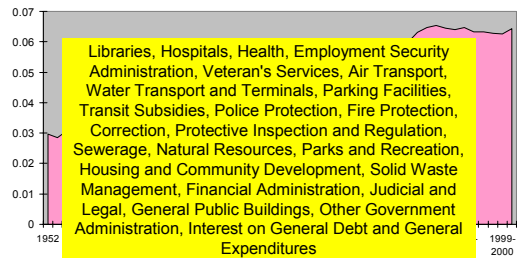
State Spending on Welfare, 1953-2001



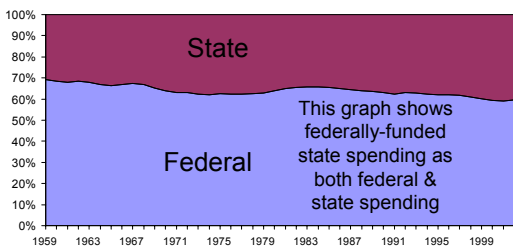

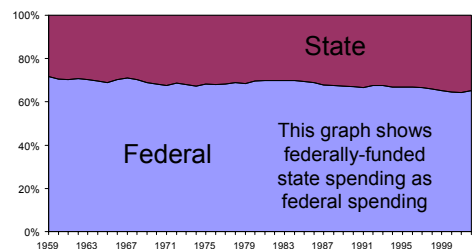

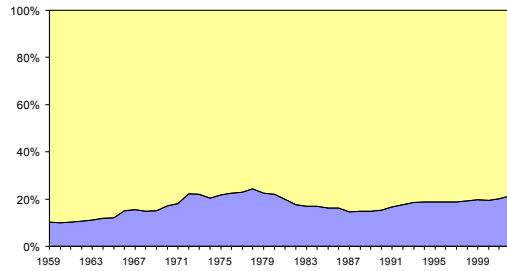
State vs. Federal, 1959-2002
