Defacing school property is a major offense. Marking your name, handprint, graduation date, etc. on anything in the classroom at any time is unacceptable.	Students will receive a deduction in points for daily lack of progress/participation. If lack of daily work progress becomes excessive, the teacher will request a parent conference.	Respect classroom technology. This includes making sure your searches are school appropriate, and you are not exceeding 15 minutes of internet searching at a time. Also, no one is permitted to remove software, programming, cords, etc. or otherwise destroy the property. This is a major privilege, which could result in your loss of privileges.
